# SDGS學生大使 網上學習先導計劃

## SDGs Student Ambassadors eLearn Pilot Scheme

### 計劃簡介

聯合國全體成員國在2015年通過了可持續發展目標（SDGs），致力消除貧窮、減少不平等，並希望在2030年之前建立更和平及繁榮的社會。SDGs亦稱為全球目標（Global Goals），呼籲各界採取行動，共同創造一個可持續發展的世界。

為促進可持續發展目標的實踐，聯合國兒童基金香港委員會（UNICEF HK）開展「SDGs學生大使網上學習先導計劃」，提供SDGs網上學習課堂和實踐行動，鼓勵學生隨時隨地自主學習，培育青少年成為SDGs學生大使，透過行動為SDGs出一分力。

### 目的

- 推廣聯合國可持續發展目標，讓學生認識及關心世界議題。
- 鼓勵學生透過多元行動為可持續發展目標出一分力，培育世界公民。
- 鼓勵學生自主學習，並連結線上及線下學習體驗。

### Programme Introduction

Adopted by all United Nations Member States in 2015, the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) aim to end poverty, reduce inequality, and establish more peaceful and prosperous societies by 2030. Also known as the Global Goals, the SDGs are a call to action to create a sustainable and inclusive world.

To translate the SDGs into action, the Hong Kong Committee for UNICEF (UNICEF HK) is launching the SDGs Student Ambassadors eLearn Pilot Scheme. Through online lessons and practical actions on the eLearn platform, the Scheme encourages self-directed learning anytime, anywhere, and empowers teenagers to become SDGs student ambassadors, enabling students to take action to contribute to Sustainable Development Goals

### Objectives


- To promote the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, to educate students and raise their awareness on global issues.

- Schools are welcome to nominate students to join the Scheme by completing the following forms and emailing them to edu@unicef.org.hk by **16 March 2026 (Monday)**.

- Each participating school should have an enrolment of **100-240** students.
- Limited places, the enrolment is on a **first-come-first-served** basis.
- Registered schools will compete for **school awards**. Students nominated by schools are eligible to compete for **student awards or team awards**.
- Registered schools will receive UNICEF HK's latest updates and awards notification.


身體力行實踐舊衣回收以幫助有需要人士

Valerie designs an engaging idiom lesson featuring the Chinese idiom "playing the lute to a cow". With visuals and interactive discussion, she explains Chinese idiom to non-Chinese-speaking students, introducing Chinese culture and language while promoting the concept of inclusive education.

- 銅章：完成 2 個網上課堂 及 最少 3 個 SDGs 行動

### 傑出表現學生獎

完成最多行動的首 10 名學生可獲「傑出表現學生獎」。得獎者會獲得 \$300 書券及證書乙張。

### 傑出 SDGs 實踐團隊獎

獲選的 2 組學生團隊各獲得 \$500 書券及獎牌作為獎勵。

### 學校獎項

- 完成最多行動的 1 間學校可獲「SDGs 卓越校園獎」。
- 參與學生人數最高的 3 間學校可獲「積極參與學校獎」(只計算完成至少 2 個必修課堂的學生)
- 各得獎學校可獲 \$1,000 書券及證書乙張。



## Awards

### Student Awards

Students accomplishing the following number of online courses and actions will be awarded Gold, Silver or Bronze Certificate.

- Gold: Completed 2 online courses and at least 7 SDGs actions
- Silver: Completed 2 online courses and at least 5 SDGs actions
- Bronze: Completed 2 online courses and at least 3 SDGs actions

### Most Active Contribution Award

In addition, the 'Most Active Contribution Award' will go to the top 10 students who accomplished the most actions.

Awardees will receive a \$300 book voucher and a certificate.

### Outstanding SDGs Actioners Team Award

2 student teams will each receive a team award of \$500 book voucher and medal awards for all members.

### School Awards

- The school with the most action accomplishments will be awarded the 'SDGs Action School Award'
- The top 3 schools with the highest number of participating students will be awarded the 'Best Participation School Award' (Only students who complete at least 2 compulsory courses will be counted)
- Awarded schools will receive a \$1,000 book voucher and a certificate.
