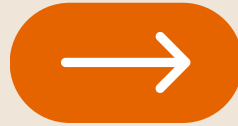


World Hunger An important problem

- donated money goes to the charity for supporting children in developed countries to get enough food and tackle hunger



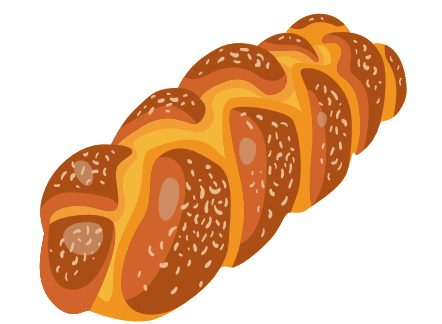
Aim of Famine lunch



Bring out the importance of food. Encourage participants to pay attention to world hunger



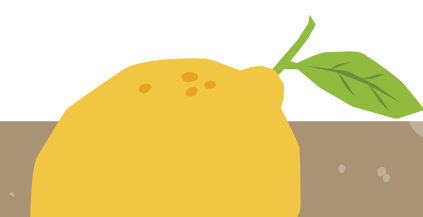
Have a taste of hunger with little porportion of food for lunch



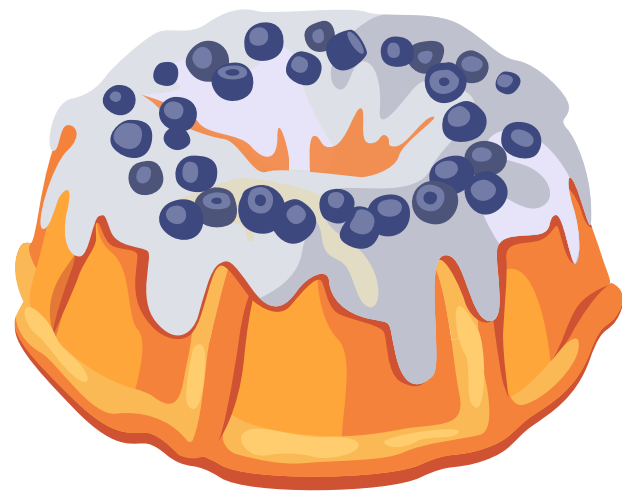
Donating money to the poeple in need

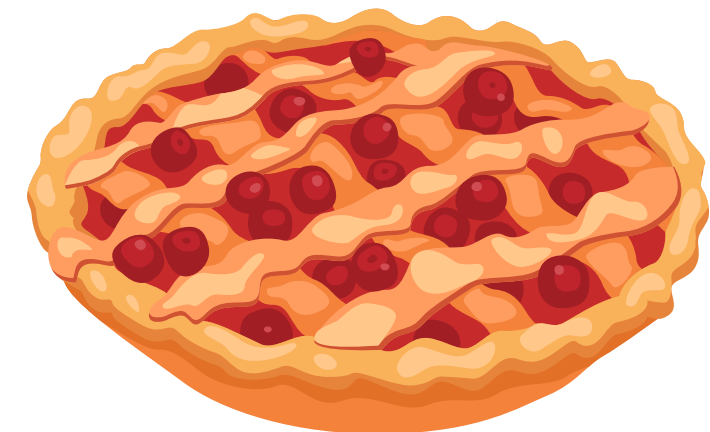

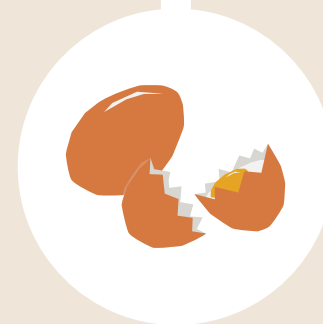
