我們的成果

ACHIEVEMENT IN 2020

雖然疫情導致停課，但不少2019/20年度UNICEF Club幹事會繼續積極參與，利用網上直播及社交媒體舉辦活動，讓同學了解更多兒童權利的議題。本學年，UNICEF Club幹事透過活動成功接觸超過8,000人次，所籌得的善款能協助UNICEF進行全球抗疫工作，包括提供2,000個防護口罩及7,000塊肥皂。

The pandemic caused class suspensions, but UNICEF Club committees in 2019/20 remained active in educating and mobilizing peers through online and social media platforms to help students gain a better understanding in child rights issues. The programme successfully reached out to over 8,000 people. The donations supported UNICEF to fight the pandemic. This helped provide 2,000 masks and 7,000 soaps.
